- Feedback from Alumni (video conferencing, personal meetings, annual alumni meet).
- The graduates and employers are included as members of various bodies (Board of Studies, IQAC/Committees/Advisory Bodies/NSS).

The college obtains feedback from the students at the entry point and at the exit point. It is obtained from the alumni through Email, discussions through video-conferencing and from the respective Board of Studies. Comments from the employers are obtained at the annual meeting of the college and from the community through various service programmes organized by the National Service Scheme, Youth Red Cross Society, Blood Donors Club, etc.

Opinions and suggestions from academic peers who attend the meeting of the Board of Studies and from those who visit the campus for guest lectures are also obtained. Further, inputs from industries, institutions, and professionals are obtained through students who undergo institutional training and project work. All courses undergo major syllabus revision once in three years incorporating major thrust areas.

The ideas obtained from the various bodies is thoroughly discussed by the experts in the academic bodies and carefully incorporated in the curriculum. Seminars, Group Discussions and Assignments are introduced as encouraging steps for the under-graduate students. These components are made compulsory in the internal assessment for all post-graduate students.
